Clubhouse International is a global non-profit organization that helps communities around the world create Clubhouses, which are community-based centers that give people with mental illness hope and opportunities to reach their full potential.

Their vision is that there will one day be Clubhouses in the cities and towns of every country in the world. We hope that all people with mental illness will have access to the support of a Clubhouse, which can provide them with the encouragement and assistance they need to lead successful lives, and be fully engaged in society.



Clubhouse Canada is dedicated to the recovery of people living with mental illness. We promote, assist and strengthen Clubhouse development across Canada, in accordance with the philosophy and standards of Clubhouse International.



Our Mandate is:

Oak Centre opened its doors as a Clubhouse in 1987. We are located in Welland, Ontario, part of the Niagara Region. We're about 20 minutes from Niagara Falls, the honeymoon capital of the world. We're surrounded on three sides by water; Lake Erie to the south, Lake Ontario to the north and the Niagara River to the east. There are two places in Canada where tender fruit is grown (juicy peaches, cherries, plums, nectarines and grapes); one is the Okanagan Valley in British Columbia and the other is the Niagara Region. Lake House is our satellite Clubhouse in Port Colborne, just south of Welland.



Niagara Falls is a city located on the western bank of the Niagara River in the Golden Horseshoe region of Southern Ontario, with a population of 82,997. The city is dominated by the Niagara Falls, a world-famous set of three large waterfalls on the Niagara River. Both the American and Horseshoe falls can be best seen from the Canadian side of the river, so the city has one of the major tourist attractions of the world. The natural spectacle attracts millions of tourists yearly.

This area, which stretches along the Niagara Parkway and tourist promenade, is particularly concentrated at the brink of the falls. Apart from the natural attractions along the river, it includes observation towers, high-rise hotels, souvenir shops, casinos and theatres, mostly with colourful neon billboards and advertisements, and sufficient parking to accommodate visitors. Further to the north or south, golf courses are operated alongside historic sites from the War of 1812.

The luxurious 5 Star Sheraton on the Falls Hotel offers the best view of the Falls Guaranteed. A dynamic location, directly across from Niagara Falls, the Sheraton on the Falls Hotel is able to provide superior views of both the Horseshoe Falls and the American Falls. Located directly across the street from majestic Niagara Falls, the Sheraton hotel is perfectly situated with an angle that puts you at eye level with the breathtaking rush.

Directly connected to the Sheraton on the Falls Hotel is the 3 acre Fallsview Indoor Waterpark, featuring enough water activities to keep the entire family entertained. Featuring 16 thrilling slides up to six stories high, a giant wave pool, two oversized adult only Jacuzzis, the beach house mammoth aqua play area, tiny tots splash park, an outdoor sun deck and activity pool, Planet Hollywood Beach Club food court and more. The hotel is offering special pricing for conference participants.
